The task will be to assist with field work and therefor mapping and collecting samples from water-filled tree holes in three different regions of Germany – Schorfheide-Chorin, Hainlich and Schwäbische Alb. The interns will gain knowledge in various sampling techniques, use of equipment and valuable research experience.

Working conditions will require an individual who will not mind or preferably enjoy working outdoors, in possibly inclement weather. The candidate should have an interest in ecology and tree-climbing experience would be preferred but is not necessary. Preference will be given to candidates with field work/research experience. Accommodation and travel expenses will be covered.
