

The European Commission has selected the **AtoSiM 2.0 master course** for its Erasmus Mundus programme.

Erasmus Mundus masters are very specific high level programmes, organized by a consortium of European top universities.

AtoSiM 2.0 is a two-year Msc which provides a top-level education in the field of computer simulation of physical, chemical and biomolecular systems.

Mobility:

All students follow courses first at Amsterdam, then at Rome, and finally in Lyon to obtain a triple diploma. The fourth semester is devoted to research in laboratories in Amsterdam, Rome, Lyon or one of the additional partners.

The AtoSiM master is taught in English.

Erasmus Mundus Scholarships:

A limited number of Scholarships is available.
Non-European students: € 1000 / per month
European students: € 500 / month
+ a fixed amount as a contribution to the participation costs (including insurance coverage) according to EU rules.

Participation Fees:

Non-European students: €4,000 per semester
European students: €2,000 per semester

>>>For EM scholarship holders, the participation fees are covered by the EM grant.
